MeridianComplete (Medicare-Medicaid Plan) is a partner with the MI Health Link program. MI Health Link offers a broad range of healthcare services, including home and community-based services (HCBS). MI Health Link's waiver program can help you continue to live safely in your home.



The MI Health Link waiver gives you the access to the care, services, and support you need to do the day-to-day activities that you may no longer be able to do. Your MeridianComplete care coordinator will work with your doctors, pharmacies, and long-term care supports to help set up the care and services you need.

MI Health Link offers a variety of waiver services and supports to members when they are medically necessary for you.

Examples of services you may be able to get include:



Adaptive medical equipment and supplies (shower chairs, raised toilet seats, transfer benches, etc.).



Respite services (relief for caregivers during unpaid time).



Expanded community living supports (supervision or reminding to complete daily tasks).



Chore services (lawn care, snow removal, pest control, etc.).



Personal Emergency Response System.



Adult day programs.



Environmental modifications (grab bars, railings, ramps, widening doorways, etc.).



Non-medical transportation.



Home delivered meals.



Preventive nursing services.



Private duty nursing.
